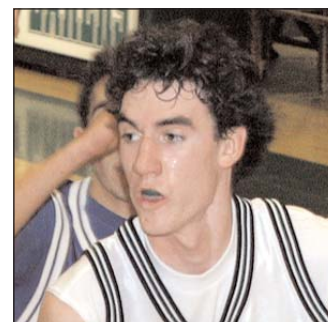

able with it.”

The Athletic Leadership Council at SMHS was started by athletic director Tom Frederick and guidance counselor Myles Cooney.

“It deals a lot with apathy and bullying,” Cooney said about the council. “Our objective was to try and convince kids to help and make our school a better place for all students.”

A huge aspect of the group is a big brother-big sister program with the elementary school.

“We try to make sure we give back to the community as much as we can,” Frederick said. “The group meets twice a month and goes over leadership issues, team chemistry, problem solving, building relationships and the school's athletic handbook.”

SMHS social studies teacher Meagan Reed has started a similar group at the Middle School to help facilitate the change of a recreation philosophy to interscholastic sports.

Sunapee elementary school teachers Bonnie Cruz and Heather Cantagello have also begun a Sportsmanship Council at their school.

“We want the kids to be examples in the school,” Cruz said. “If the kids feel a sense of pride about their school, it makes them feel good and the kids on the council tend to do a little bit extra.”

This year’s elementary school sportsmanship council is for fourth and fifth graders.

The SMHS students on the council who presented at the conference were senior Phil Parsons, juniors Robbie Titus, Erik Skarin and Maggie Hurd, sophomores Alie Fazio and Allison Tenney and freshmen Troy Fowler and Liza Bourdon.

Being out in the community is very important to these high school students.

“As a group we go out in the community and we get to see different people’s opinions,” Parsons said. “It is a different perspective than the ones we get in our school.”

Working with the elementary school kids is also an important part of the work done by the athletic council.

“It’s fun seeing how they are when we come to the school,” Parsons said. “They like to know what it’s like to play sports at the high school level.”

In addition to presenting on March 20, the Sunapee contingent at the conference was in charge of Thursday afternoon’s meet and greet at the Courtyard Marriott in Concord.

“The conference is to expose and develop students to leadership skills to help their teams,” Frederick said. “It is a really good experience for our kids.”

Several topics were covered over the short two-day conference including, “Violence in Sports” by Rev. Robert Odierna; “Creating a Leadership Council” by the Sunapee students and Frederick; “Relationship Building” by Charles Lloyd and Marty Hunt from New Hampshire Technical Institute; “Be an Overcomer” by Jim Warren, CEO/Sports Performance Technologies; “Being Responsible and Modeling Appropriate Behavior” by Jimmy Odierna, Newbury College Soccer Coach; “Sportsmanship: How to Lead by Example” by Jeff Cloos, Winnisquam A.D.; “Acquiring Life’s Lessons through Sports” by Kim Kenny Merrimack Valley Coach; and “Developing Proper Leadership and Ethical Behavior” by Chris Brooks.
