## Cards enter Class M fray

*Stevens baseball wants to be competitive in new division*

**CLAREMONT** - Stevens baseball coach Paul Silva hopes his third season will be the charm for the Cardinals.

This season will mark Stevens' first in Class M and the Cardinals have their sights set on making a run at a tourney

berth.

"We are new to Class M and we know there are plenty of teams in this class that can really play baseball and a good deal of them are on our schedule," Silva said. "Our goal is to be competitive, game in and game out, and contend for a play-off spot."

Silva has been associated with the pro-

gram for several years as his father Ralph was the varsity coach for more than 30 years and is currently his top assistant. Silva was an assistant from 2004-2006 and the junior varsity coach in 2006 before taking over before the start of the 2007 season.

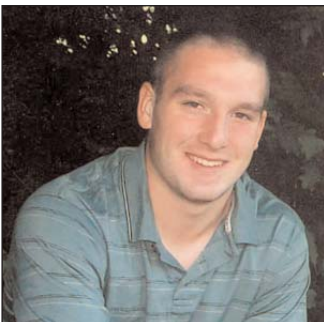

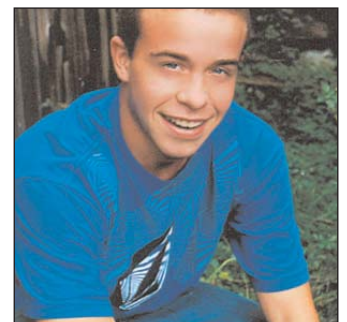

ed the season 1-10 before putting things together and finishing 5-13.

"We got off to a very rough start going 1-10, but the kids battled back and we finished the season winning four of our last seven games including a 10-7 victory over Lebanon after getting destroyed by them 29-6 in our first meeting," Silva said. "I was very pleased with how the kids finished the season."

Gone from last year's team are Ryan Hoyt, Nate Duford, Josh Duford, Steve Condon and Joe Landry, who provided the majority of the offense.

Back this season are seniors Matt Day and Chad Davidson and juniors Isaac Sweet, Cody Nichols and Ethan Yazinski.

Newcomers to the squad are senior Travis Drawing, sophomores Zach Melcher, Ben Smolnik and Kevin O'Connor and freshman Cam Blewitt.

"Cam should be a player to watch," Silva said. "He will be the starting shortstop as a freshman. He will also see time on the mound and behind the plate."

With the early snow-melt, the Cards have been able to pretty much practice outdoors since the start of spring training.

"We were only in the gym for two days so that was a major relief," Silva said. "It has been so nice to get out in the sunshine on a full field and get to work on actual baseball situations, get some hitting in and get to throw the ball around."

Stevens has a full slate of scrimmages to get ready for the season. The Cards have already scrimmaged Springfield a couple of times and Sunapee. Stevens still has a scrimmage upcoming with Newport and one with Mascoma. Stevens is also hosting a jamboree at Franklin Pierce College, which will include Keene, Kearsarge and Hopkinton.

"I think it will help by getting outside earlier this year and getting in the scrimmages," Silva said. "The only way I know for a player to get better in this sport is to

play the game. If we can dodge the rain-drops and get the majority of our scrimmages in it should really help the younger players prepare for the season. I am looking forward to seeing what this group of kids can do."

The Cardinals will open the season by playing Conant at Barnes Park April 17.

In addition to Ralph Silva assisting with the varsity, Ryan Seaver is back for his second season as coach of the junior varsity.

"We have 26 players in the program with 17 of them sophomores and freshmen," Silva said. "We will be starting a freshman and as many as four sophomores and expect that they will all be contributors. I really like the team chemistry I have seen this spring throughout the entire program. The kids have a very good work ethic and I am confident that they will play hard and give it everything they've got, from the first pitch to the last. That's all a coach can ask."

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# Scott wins state swimming title

**EXETER, N.H.** - The Claremont Tiger Sharks swim team had a very competitive weekend at the New Hampshire Swimming Association 2009 Championship at Phillips Exeter Academy March 20-22.

There were 15 teams with more than 1,100 swimmers. The Tiger Sharks were the smallest team at the meet with 33 swimmers. Despite being the smallest team, Claremont had over 60 personal best times.

Hannah Scott led the way for Coach Patty Deschaine's team capturing the 10-year 50-yard freestyle state title. Scott was seeded fourth out of 108 swimmers.

"I was nervous when Hannah was getting ready to swim the event," Deschaine said. "She did everything necessary to win the event and I'm very proud of her."

The Tiger Sharks won 10 medals and several ribbons.

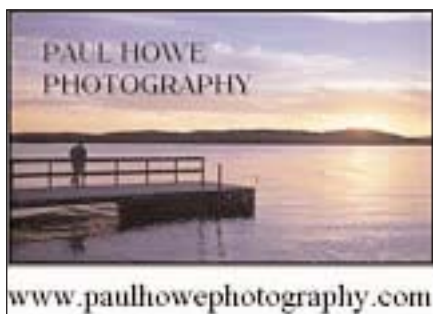
